### WHAT IS AP?

- Advanced Placement is an exam that offers university-level content to students at the high school level.
- Students can earn advanced credit for a university course in English.
- All university programs require an English credit for graduation ... you don't have to be an English major to write this exam.

# WHEN & WHERE IS THE EXAM?

- The first week of May each year.
- Written at one of WCDSB's high schools
- o Cost \$90

### BENEFITS OF AP

- <u>Enrichment</u> students engage with English literature in greater depth and breadth
- <u>Flexibility</u> AP practice material can be accessed on-line and at WCDSB sponsored prep sessions (Feb. 16, March 8 & April 19)
- <u>Challenge</u> AP gives students the opportunity to challenge themselves with university level material
- <u>University Preparation</u> allows students to feel comfortable and have more confidence once they reach university; research shows students who prepared for AP have a high success rate at university
- <u>International recognition</u> 90% of North American universities and colleges recognize AP in their admissions process
- <u>Rigorous Standards</u> AP courses are administered by the American College Board and are graded according to rigorous AP standards. Each AP exam is given a grade on a 5-point scale (5 = Extremely well qualified 4 = Well qualified 3 = Qualified 2 = Possibly Qualified 1 = No recommendation)
