Reference Article in an Online Database

Article Author (if given) last name, first name. "Article title". *Reference Book Title*. Editor of reference book. Edition. City: Publisher, Year. Volumes. *Title of Database*. Web. Date of access.

Magazine Article in an Online Database

Article author (if given) last name, first name. "Article title". *Magazine/newspaper Title*. Volume.Number (Year of publication): page numbers. *Title of the database*. Web. Date of access.

Web Site (non-periodical)

Web site author (if given) last name, first name. *Website Title*. Publication Date. Publisher or Sponsor. Date of publication (if available). Web. Date accessed.

City of Cambridge, Ontario, Canada. *The Corporation of the City of Cambridge*. Web. 12 Jan. 2010.

Scholarly Journal

Article author (if given) last name, first name. "Article title". *Magazine/newspaper Title*. Volume.Number (Year of publication): page numbers. Web. Date of access.
