

**Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test Day
March 27, 2019**

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

This is a notice regarding a schedule change on the day of the *Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test*, on **Wednesday, March 27th, 2019**.

Students in Grade 10, or in Grades 11 and 12 who have not written or were previously unsuccessful, may be eligible to write the test this year. If you believe you are eligible to write the test but did not receive a letter, please notify us by contacting Mr. Schade at 519 622-1290 ext. 226.

- Students who are **required to write** the test are to **be in their designated location at 8:30am**
- **Gr. 9 and 10 Students not writing the OSSLT** are to **attend classes in the afternoon only** as per the schedule below.

***Gr. 11 and 12 Students not writing the OSSLT** will be given assignments in advance by classroom teachers. Study hall spaces at school for periods 3 and 4 will be made available for teacher support **or** students may choose to complete their assignments at home. Further information will be provided by classroom teachers prior to March 27th.

All students are expected to be in full uniform.
