It is used at least until grade 10, and there is access up to grade 12. - Can access from School or home. - IPP (Individualized Pathway Plan) 	Jenn Ertel	40 mins

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			<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Have a number of tasks that they can complete each year.- Tasks are usually completed before end of Jan.- They can choose their courses.- Create a portfolio.- There are surveys (ex: Learning Style Survey), which allow students to take ownership of their learning behaviours once they get to High School.- Students can complete survey multiple times, allowing them to see how they've changed over the years.- They can also use the results of the surveys, to identify potential future careers.- Parents can also opt to be notified about changes to their student's blueprint.- Talked about courses across the grade spectrum. Less compulsory in Grade 11/12.- They can look at different types of careers, the requirements (types, and lengths), and even the provincial estimated salary.- Resume starts getting compiled in Grade 8. By the time they get to grade 10 (when they can		
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			start a part-time job), and need to complete their resume, majority of data is already there.
