Grade 8 – meeting with our incoming students getting them to understand the different pathways out there and how to get to them through high school courses.	Oscar	5 min

Grade 9 – course selection meetings through classes in February to address pathways (all of them) and how to get there.3. Grade 10 – Career Studies is an extension of the guidance department. Focus is on all pathways, opportunities in each, profiling specific jobs in each area, learning about their interests, who they are and how those link to pathway opportunities. MyBlueprint is a major focus of this course – it is a phenomenal tool to research jobs, pathways, career sectors, programs at post-secondary, understanding yourself through not only interest inventories but compatibility quizzes for careers.4. Grade 10 – SHSM presentations begin. Focus on multiple pathways within the 10 sectors offered at Doyle. These presentations occur in grade 11 and 12 classes as well through teachers who sign up for them.5. Grade 11 – 11UP presentation at course selection time. We meet with all grade 11 classes and focus on everything that happens in grade 11 and onward. Our focus is pathways and how to get there, research tools to use for more pathway research besides using myBlueprint.6. Grade 11 – Spring interview (one on one)– Reviewing course selections with a discussion regarding their first (and possibly second) pathway choice after high school. Reviewing course selection to ensure their courses make sense in regards to their pathways and/or post-secondary

Grade 12 – Fall presentations (one for college bound students, one for university bound students). Reviewing the processes, research tools, letting students know of the schools that will be coming into Doyle to meet with students.8. Grade 12 – Fall interview – Pathway interview to ensure students who are post-secondary bound have the required courses/programming to get where they want to in their future. Reviewing research tools to ensure they know where to look for requirements and cut off grades if college or university bound.9. Grade 12 – School visits, Fair info, Open House info.10. Grade 10-12 – Trades Presentation – Winter.
