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| | | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- It's a memo going out to WCDSB around policies & procedures. Pretty consistent.- Affected cell phones, vaping, code of conduct (aka: professionalism, and a few others)- No cell phone / personal devices used within a school, including ear buds, smart watches, cell phones; effectively any electronic device that isn't being used for academics.- Phones should not be out, unless a teacher dictates otherwise.- Should be focused on academics.- Using judgement, but:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- 1st time: Put it away.- If there's a consistent issue, the phone is surrendered; teacher is asking, and student is expected to surrender it until end of class.- If the issue continues to persist, it goes to the main office, and it stays there until the end of the day. Office will let the parent(s) know.- If there's some sort of emergency, kid should go to the office, so that they can call their parents.- If they need to be picked up, parents should contact the school, and the office can ensure student is available to be picked up. It ends up being more effective, since the main office would need to verify either way.- Vaping is a health issue; we're trying to educate.<ul style="list-style-type: none">- The consequence has not changed with regards to vaping. | | |
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		<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Automatic 1 day suspension, if caught with vape to mouth.- A vape is no longer a permitted item in <i>any</i> school.- If a school official sees it, it becomes confiscated. Had 10 instances last year, haven't seen it once this year.- Parents are called immediately.- General sense that it starts in Grade 9, and trying to curb that (aka: prevent students from getting started / from their friends).- Smoking is the same. Not allowed to smoke or vape anywhere on school property + 20 meters.- Code of conduct:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- There is an expectation that any staff responds to any query within 48 hours (business hours) with an acknowledgement of receipt. <p>PPM170</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Inform parents / community whenever we have a guest speaker.- Need to send that out 2 weeks in advance, mainly for transparency, so that parents can decide whether their kids should attend.- If there's some question from the parents about whether the kids should / should not attend, it's an opportunity to have a dialog with the staff, and that is encouraged. <p>High expectations for students and for staff (48 hours)</p>
